The Police Evidence and Forensic Science Facility is located at the Anne Arundel County Public Safety Campus in Millersville, MD. Situated between the Fire Headquarters and the Animal Control Building, the new 55,071 SF project will house the Biology/DNA Lab, CDS Drug Lab, Crime Scene Unit, Latent Fingerprint Unit, and Photo Unit, as well as administration, staff offices and support areas, and a training room.
